INCUBATE

Coach Qualifications:

- Believer with a strong faith foundation and lifestyle
- Track record of success in business. Ideally as an entrepreneur who launched a company but also an individual with senior level experience in running and developing a business.
- A heart for mentoring and well-developed coaching and communication skills.
- Testimony of integrating faith into their work and organizations.
- Attend Incubate boot camp as an observer.
- Attend and participate in Incubate Seminar series.
- Been recommended or qualified by a recognized leader in our network.



Certification

 Not required to have program certification but we will be vetting coach background experience and faith-based principles + requiring to adhere to program training and toolsets

Role and Responsibility:

- Actively participate in and contribute to the Incubate coaching community training and events.
- Be available to serve as breakout group leader for our Seminar series.
- Meet no less than at least once monthly with their assigned entrepreneur for 1:1 mentoring.
 - Use Uptick App for performance management and tracking.
- Be reasonably available between 1:1 meetings with entrepreneur for counsel.
- Provide regular feedback to the Executive Team and contribute to the knowledge and content base of the program.

Mindset





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
- Avodah: Work, Worship and Service it isn't just business, it's marketplace ministry
