APPLICATION PROCESS

Once your application is submitted and reviewed, we will contact you to let you know the status of your application.

The following minimum requirements must be met in order for an applicant to be accepted into the Thrive Community Leader Training Program.

- 1. Agree to adhere to the AFB Mission and Statement of Faith
- 2. Be an active AFB Member (free/donation based)
- 3. Attends or has attended at least 3 Thrive events
- 4. Be involved in a local faith community or small group
- 5. Has recent positional leadership experience in a faith or business setting
- 6. Is willing to commit 3-4 hours per month to facilitating meetings, following up with members and assisting in coordinating community events.
- Will commit to Lead or Co-lead a Thrive Community Group for at least two years.

If you have met the minimum requirements, we will request additional information from you including: personal and professional references and a brief phone interview.

If approved, your final step will be the signing of the Thrive Community Leader agreement and then you'll be ready to move into the training phase.
